3. Tucking into materials on regulations and laws related to the Village and BUMDes.

### The role of youth as Agents of Change in the improvement of BUMDes program in Bah Butong Village:

- 1. Political education and democratization, namely holding seminars on elections.
- 2. Economic resources, namely the reduction of unemployment stemming from youth age.
- 3. Concern for the community, namely in 2019 BUMDes involving youth held public competitions and blood donation events.
- 4. Science and technology, namely donating textbooks to disadvantaged students.
- 5. Sports, arts, and culture, namely being a sponsor in arts and cultural performance events and sports matches.
- 6. Concern for the environment, namely doing greening and campaigning the movement of waste in its place.
- 7. Entrepreneurship education, which is organizing entrepreneurial trainings with young people.
- 8. Youth leadership and pioneering, namely always conduct leadership trainings that involve the youth of Bah Butong Village.

### Constraints on the Role of Youth in Improving BUMDes Bah Butong Program

Internal Constraints, namely money, BUMDes management is not good, and lack of control and maintenance of equipment rented. External constraints, namely the low education of youth, the potential of nature in Bah Butong Village that still can not be managed, many groups of parents are less supportive of the ideas and activities of youth Bah Butong Village, many activities that are made by the youth in increasing BUMDes program less get a good response, and natural disasters.

### IV. CONCLUSION

Internal factors of youth in BUM Nagori Sinar Harapan program such as still not good financial, management is still not good, the difficulty of uniting the vision between the old and the young so that less support is built and lack of control and evaluation on every activity and program running in BUM Nagori Sinar Harapan that has been set. External factors are the lack of education level of the youth, lack of awareness in order to manage the existing natural potenssi well, the lack of positive response from the community to the ideas and ideas raised by the youths in Bah Butong village and natural disasters.
